4. TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES - MANGAROA ROAD - 19 APRIL 2015 AND ANZAC DAY SERVICES - 24 - 25 APRIL 2015

A) That the report of the Transportation Officer titled “Temporary Road Closures - Mangaroa Road - 19 April 2015 and ANZAC Day Services - 24 - 25 April 2015” dated 26/03/2015 be received.

B) That, there being no submissions received, the Temporary Road Closures Subcommittee approve the following temporary road closures, as amended:

- **Mangaroa Road from the intersection with Maraekakaho Road to the**

intersection with Ru Collin Road – being 879m of sealed road. The road closure will be between 9:00am until 5:00pm, Sunday, 19 April 2015.

- C) That, there being no submissions received, the Temporary Road Closures Subcommittee approve the following temporary road closures to enable the ANZAC Day commemorative service:
- Russell Street between Eastbourne Street and Lyndon Road – 7am, Friday, 24 April – 5:00pm, Saturday, 25 April 2015
 - Lyndon Road East between Railway Road and Hastings Street - 3:00am – 12noon Saturday, 25 April 2015
 - Karamu Road South between Southampton Street and Lyndon Road East – 3:00am – 12noon, Saturday, 25 April 2015
 - Warren Street between Lyndon Road and Heretaunga Street – 3:00am – 12noon, Saturday, 25 April 2015
 - Eastbourne Street between Hastings Street and Railway Road – 3:00am – 12noon, Saturday, 25 April 2015
 - Karamu Road between Heretaunga Street and Eastbourne Street – 3:00am – 12noon, Saturday, 25 April 2015
 - Heretaunga Street East between Karamu Road and Russell Street – 3:00am – 12noon, Saturday, 25 April 2015
 - Russell Street South between Queen Street and Eastbourne Street – 3:00am – 12noon, Saturday, 25 April 2015
- D) That, there being no submissions received, the Temporary Road Closures Subcommittee approve the above temporary road closures subject to the conditions to be complied with to the satisfaction of the Group Manager: Asset Management:
1. This event is conducted in accordance with the New Zealand Transport Agency Code of Practice Temporary Traffic Management (CoPTTM).
 2. The supplied Traffic Management Plans containing appropriate signage are approved.
 3. Separate copies of the relevant liability insurance policies are received.
 4. That the cost of all advertising is met by the event organisers.
 5. Emergency Services are contacted regarding the holding of this event.
 6. The Hawke's Bay Car Club event shall be conducted in accordance with the requirements of the Motorsport New Zealand Motor Sport

Manual, National Sporting Code and Appendices.

With the reasons for this decision being that the objective of the decision will contribute to the performance of regulatory functions by:

- i) That the use of the above listed roads for this short period of time will not unreasonably impede traffic.**
- ii) By allowing the above temporary road closures the organisers can undertake their events in a safe and controlled environment with all risks minimised and managed.**
