Whilst I think there has been some misinformation in this process, I feel that this proposal is ok for now. I feel this system needs a revamp and over the next period the public needs more information on the demographics, fairer representation and where the public votes come from. I do not agree that council will be less efficient or that elected counciliors will be less engaged or that the council will be any less diversified. I also do not think this is about the remuneration of councillors either. If there is a decrease in councillors, does that mean the next councillor to get the chop will be a rural councillor? From my point of view, not a good thought and one that would be vigorously defended by such a community of interest.

No comparison can be made to Wellington which is less than an hours drive from 1 side to the other. Having I more councilor to allow for 3 Maori councilors is a fair way to provide representation throughout the district. Bural people value democracy as they have higher turnout at elections than urban areas. This would likely be due to the very high rates paid on rural properties. Retaining the rural community board is a good idea. I won't comment on urban wards as I do not live there. I find the proposal to increase the number of councillors to be far from the best thing for democracy in Hastings. I believe the Hastings community would be better served and represented if there were fewer councillors, working full-time and renumerated as such so that one of the many barriers to more diverse representation can be removed – diversity in their age, ethnicity and background. At the very least, the status quo of 14 councillors should be retained.

While I commend the council on establishment Māori wards, it should not be to the detriment to the representation of a high needs area like Flaxmere.

The proposed under representation of Flaxmere is, in my opinion, appalling.

While I'm sure the rationale exists that the new Māori wards will represent Flaxmere by default, there is no guarantee that the people in those seats will come from Flaxmere as opposed to Hastings, Whakatu, Havelock North or the Rural Areas. I believe the assumption that someone's ethnicity means that they understand and will advocate for a community they do not necessarily live in is wrong. If this were accurate, ALL councillors (in both the Māori and general wards) would be at large.

Assuming that Māori wards will be responsible for Flaxmere is also undemocratic. If those in the Māori wards are under-performing for the people of Flaxmere - whether they are Māori, European, Asian or Pasifika, then what recourse do the non-Māori members of that ward have under the current proposal? If the dedicated Flaxmere counciliors under perform, then they can voted out - this is true fair representation.

Introduction

Federated Farmers thanks the Hastings District Council for the opportunity to submit on the Representation Review. We support comments made by individual members of Federated Farmers.

Federated Farmers feedback represents the views of over a hundred and eighty local Hastings farming members and rate payers. We gently remind the Council of this so that their representation views, expressed here, are weighed appropriately.

Federated Farmers appreciates that the Local Electoral Act 2001 requires the Council to review representation arrangements every six years. We understand that the Council's decision to establish Māori wards has precipitated this representation review.

Federated Farmers considers that more democracy is better than less, so we do not oppose the establishment of Maori wards on the condition that there is no decrease in rural ward representation.

Rural People Value Democracy

Our members and other rural people value democracy. Local government issues are of particular importance to the farming community. Numerically speaking, farmers would be a minority in almost every local authority, yet the reliance of a property value-based rating system for funding local authorities means that farmers are significant contributors to local authority revenue. Farmers are also subject to considerable regulation by local authorities for the use of land and other resources that occur in rural areas (e.g. biodiversity).

Therefore local government representation is very important to the Federation and we advocate to both central and local government to ensure fair representation for farmers.

This is evidenced in the nation-wide trend of high rural voter turn-out for local government elections, compared to urban electors. The rural Mohaka and Kahuranaki wards enjoyed 42.60% and 46.08% voter turn-out respectively, for the 2019 local government election.

These nation-wide statistics were presented by LGNZ on the 2019 election comparing voter turn-out, Hastings is classified as a Provincial council:

Number of Councillors

Federated Farmers is pleased that the proposal has not increased the total number of councillors dramatically.



We support provision being made for the 3 new Maori ward councillors by removing one councillor from each of the urban wards for Flaxmere, Hastings-Havelock North and Heretaunga. It is likely that the Maori ward candidates will come from these areas anyway, however we remain optimistic that candidates may a rural background. We would oppose any proposal to reduce our rural councillors in order to reduce total councillor numbers, or to provide for the Takitium councillors.

We are very pleased that the rural wards of Kahuranki and Mohaka will retain one councillor each and will not be combined or councillor numbers reduced. We supported these two rural wards in the previous representation review, when the 2014 rural ward was split into the two current wards.

The change from 9 councillors in 2014 to 14 in 2019 increased the Hastings and Havelock North had some good aspects, and some not so good aspects as far as rural representation is concerned. Total councillor numbers increased from 4 councillors out of a total of 9, to 8 councillors out of a total of 12, massively increasing the influence of urban Hastings/Havelock from 44% then to 66% in 2019.

A diverse skillset and knowledge base is essential to good governance. Rural ward councillors bring different skills and insights to the table, which benefits the entire district. Being a food bowl of the nation and providing so much export income, there must be some councillors that can adequately represent rural and primary production populations of Hastings District.

other councils, rural wards have been removed or combined or their representation reduced, despite occupying significant geographical areas and representing significant rateable value of the district.

The importance of ensuring that there is adequate rural representation on Council cannot be understated. The rural sector has service priorities different from urban centres proving difficult to represent effectively without the additional complications of complying with population equity requirements.

These two rural councillors for the Mohaka and Kahuranaki wards provide representation for a massive geographical with a diverse and dispersed population, and provide the rural representation to balance the 10 councillors from the urban-based wards of Hastings/Havelock North, Flaxmere, and Heretaunga.

Rural councillors are visible, accessible, and accountable to the rural people they represent at the Council table. They drive on the same roads, struggle with the same rural connectivity issues, attend local meetings, have or had land-based occupations, use local services and are on the ground to help their community when needed.

The Local Electoral Act 2001 requires local authorities to provide for 'the 'fair representation of electors' by ensuring there's a reasonably equal ratio of people per councillor (the "+/- 10% rule"). Exceptions can be made where:

- non-compliance is required for effective representation of communities of interest within island communities or isolated communities
- compliance would limit effective representation of communities of interest by dividing a community of interest
- compliance would limit effective representation of communities of interest by uniting two or more communities of interest with few commonalities.

We support the population per elected member. We agree with the Council that the slight overrepresentation for Kahurānaki (at -11.61%) and Heretaunga (at -11.28%) is acceptable. We agree with the Council that the predominant rural and horticultural land uses provides a community of interest for each ward, and boundary adjustments would mean bringing in citizens that have different interests and priorities, reducing effective representation.

Ward boundary changes.

Retirement villages: We agree with the Council that the three retirement villages be shifted out of the Heretaunga ward and into the Hastings-Havelock North wards, due to their urban residential land use.

Ngatarawa Triangle: We agree with the Ngatarawa triangle shift from Kahuranaki ward and into the Heretaunga ward due to its viticulture/horticulture land use.

Omahu Road Industrial: We are not sure about the proposed boundary change for Omahu Road industrial area be shifted from the urban Flaxmere Ward into the horticultural Heretaunga Ward. We agree that the whole road (both sides) should be in the same ward. The rezoning of Omahu Road to industrial in Variation 1 to the District Plan since the previous representation review does necessitate a change. But perhaps the industrial properties along Omahu Road would share more values with the urban Hastings-Havelock North ward (which includes other industrial commercial land uses and ratepayers) than with the horticultural Heretaunga ward.

Omahu Village: We agree that Omahu village no longer shares the same values as the rural Mohaka ward, and should go into the same ward as the rest of the village on the other side of the river. Going into the Heretunga ward is the most logical conclusion, due to being on the boundary anyway. However we are not sure if the village residents have much in common with the horticultural-primary production values of the Heretaunga ward, given that they don't have these same primary production values with the Mohaka ward. Perhaps have more commonalities with the next nearest ward, being

Flaxmere which also has a residential village land use. We would like to know how many Maori Roll voters and General Roll voters will be affected by the ward boundary change.

Rural Community Board

Federated Farmers supports the retention of the rural community board, and we support the election of board members. We are pleased that the four electoral subdivisions remain with some adjustments, with one board member to be elected from each.

Federated Farmers appreciates that when undertaking a Representation Review, s 19J of the LEA requires the Council to consider whether community boards are appropriate to provide fair and effective representation. Hastings District farmers value their rural community board and enjoy the accessibility of their rural board members. A rural community board should not be viewed as a proxy for rural councillors. The rural community board and rural ward councillors are both needed in the Hastings District.

Community boards are not the same as councillors. Community boards "...heip represent and advise councils on community views. They sometimes carry out delegated council service delivery or regulatory responsibilities." In contrast, councillors are "...representatives and leaders of their communities, their role involves setting policies, making regulatory decisions and reviewing council performance..." In other words, a community board reports to the council, they do not sit on it and make decisions like a Councillor does. This demonstrates why both are needed, and rural Councillors need to remain as well as a Rural Community Board.

However we are not sure about the appointment of three councillors, which is an increase from two. The third appointee from the Takitimu ward may not be a rural person, which is contrary to the purpose of the rural community board. The other two appointees are from the rural wards, so have been elected by their rural constituents and are likely to have rural backgrounds or occupations themselves.

The Council website describes the purpose of the rural community board: As the voice of the rural community, the Board looks after rural matters for which the council is responsible; such as rural roads, berms and culverts, bridge repairs and maintenance and rural halls.

The potential for an urban appointee on the board could undermine the purpose of the board as being a rural voice for rural people.

The Hastings-Havelock North Ward and the Flaxmere Ward are insufficiently represented under the new proposal. Since Covid there have been many more people coming to Hawke's Bay from overseas and New Zealand and the village has expanded around Arataki subdivision and the new settlements around Brookvale and Iona Roads to come. With the three Retirement Complexes (Graceland, Summerset in the Orchard and Sir James Wattie) now also included in this Ward, reducing it from 8 to 7 makes no sense. The Flaxmere Ward tops the representation per capita and exceeds your +/-10% rule by quite a bit. Looking at the 2018 Census the number of people in urban areas will have increased significantly and as a Council you would have more accurate numbers! would have thought.

I believe therefore that the status quo of 8 for Hastings-Havelock and 2 for Flaxmere should be retained and the Takitimu Ward be reduced to 1 councillor as s/he would work alongside all Ward Councillors already in the Wards. The Hastings Youth Council's Submission on Representation Review

Thank you for the opportunity to submit on the initial Representation Review Proposal.

While the Hastings Youth Council supports Council's decision to introduce Māori wards, we oppose the Initial Proposal. The following outlines our concerns.

 Equity in representation - Running for Council is inaccessible to many people in our community, particularly youth and those in full time work

Youth and working aged people will be further underrepresented if this proposal is adopted.

Currently, during this council's term, each councillor receives a base salary of \$43,332 per year, and up to \$65,146 before becoming the Deputy Mayor or Mayor ('Local Government Members (2020/21) Determination 2020'). Furthermore, the role is only classified as a part time job of 20 hours per week, however it is well-known that councillors regularly exceed these hours.

Practically, this means young and working-aged people often cannot afford to run for council, as they would be required to forgo their full-time employment to allow time for their role as a councillor (as flexible work hours are not feasible for many employers). Consequently, youth and working age people are reluctant to, and infrequently run for council. Only the independently wealthy, pensioners, or business owners (who can choose their hours) have the finances and time to take on the role. As such, the Hastings District Youth Council desires the opposite happen, with less councillors, more working hours per-councillor and therefore greater salary for each councillor.

The Hastings District Youth Council opposes this initial proposal because it does the opposite of what we desire, proposing an increase in the number of councillors from 14 to 15 (excluding the Mayor). Because the remuneration pool for council is limited, councillor salary will decrease with this proposal, further making the role inaccessible to youth and working aged people. This is contrary to 'fair and effective representation for individuals and communities' (Local electoral Act 2001).

We believe this is an important matter of representation because youth and under 40 year olds are a significant group in our community and the future of our community. At present over 50% of Hastings councillors are over the age of 65, whilst only 16.75% of the Hastings community are aged 65yrs or over. Yet 29.35% of our Hastings population are between the ages of 14 and 40. Only one councillor, or 7.14% of councillors, are within this age band (based on 2018 census statistics). Even more disappointingly, no councillors are under the age of 35. These statistics clearly indicate that youth and working age populations are significantly Māoriunderrepresented, partly due to salary and the quantity and regularity of councillor work hours.

Flaxmere community is underrepresented

The proposal by council under-represents Flaxmere's community by a unacceptable margin of 14%. We oppose this outcome as it is unfair and irresponsible for a number of reasons.

Firstly, some councillors believe that despite breaching the + or - 10% rule, the Flaxmere community will be sufficiently represented because this proposal would introduce three Māori Ward Councillors with the rationale being that 40% of Flaxmere's population are Māori. Councillor Redstone expressed this view in a comment on a Hawke's Bay Today Facebook post saying

"Although concern has been voiced over the Flaxmere representation decreasing there will be 3 Maori Ward councillors and half of Flaxmere's population is Maori so in fact there will be one dedicated councillor and 3 others representing the community."

We oppose this view and see it as inappropriate for several reasons:

- a) it assumes that one or all of the Māori Ward councillors will be from Flaxmere (which, despite claims from the Mayor that Māori candidates from Flaxmere intending to run, cannot be guaranteed) and;
- b) it assumes a Māori Ward councillor from outside Flaxmere can represent the whole of Flaxmere simply by virtue of being Māori. Such a proposal views all Māori as part of one monolithic cohort without acknowledging differing views, whakapapa, tūrangawaewae, and tikanga between lwi and Hapū. This makes clear the rationale of this premise is flawed, undemocratic and somewhat naive.

Elected members of the past have found it offensive to suggest that because they are Māori, they can speak for all Māori. The same principle applies here, wherein it is unfair to suggest a Māori ward councillor has to also represent Flaxmere because council decided it was a good idea to remove a Flaxmere seat. Councillors should not be forced to speak for extra communities other than their designated ward just because Council made the irresponsible decision to underrepresent Flaxmere.

Secondly, we view this as unfair and irresponsible as Flaxmere's population and developments are expected to grow significantly between now and the next representation review, after which two Local Government Elections will have occurred. This will see Flaxmere's population and needs further under-represented as time progresses. It is right and fair that the Flaxmere community have a strong voice at the council table.

More councillors mean less efficiency when decision making

Whilst a diversity of backgrounds is important, increasing the number of councillors will come at the cost of efficient decision making. The Youth Council believes our current number of councillors, let alone more councillors, inhibits timely decision making.

Increased councillor accountability

The Youth Council believes an increase in the number of councillors will dilute each councillor's accountability to council decisions, and vice versa. The Youth Council believes this proposal exacerbates this issue.

The Hastings District Youth Council asks the Hastings District Council to seriously consider how best to achieve 'fair and effective representation for individuals and communities' as outlined in the Local Electoral Act 2001.

Is 7.14% of Councillors representing 29.14% of our population fair and effective representation?

is the 14% under-representation of the Flaxmere Ward fair and effective representation?

Is telling Maori Ward Councillors they must represent the Flaxmere community fair and effective representation?

In summary

The Hastings District Youth Council opposes the initial proposal for representation because it does not achieve 'fair and effective representation for individuals and communities' as required by the Local Electoral Act 2001. We seek reconsideration of this initial proposal for

an alternative representation option, one that does not increase, and preferably reduces the number of elected councillors.

My reasons for doing so are as follows:

 Flaxmere will be disadvantaged.
 Flaxmere is a low socio-economic area with high deprivation and complex needs. Thanks to the housing crisis, it is also an area of housing growth which is why I struggle to understand the justification for this proposed under representation. Council's proposal appears to target a vulnerable community who have historically low voter and consultation turnout with a representation shortfall that would not stand in any other ward. Providing 14% less representation for Flaxmere when compared to other proposed wards does not provide for fair representation and should not be adopted.

- The rural community is unfairly advantaged. I could support this over representation if Flaxmere were not being so significantly under represented as a consequence. I hope that council will reconsider its proposal and ensure Flaxmere has a greater voice at Council.
- We need more dedicated councillors, not more of them. Increasing the number of councillors decreases accountability and increases barriers to Council diversity. A fair Council is one that looks more like its community. This means more ethnic diversity and fewer retirees. Reducing the number of councillors will make the role a close to full time one which will remove the barriers to younger and more diverse candidates standing.

Kia ora Hastings Council,

I support the decision to introduce Māori wards, however, I do not support the current proposal put forward by Council. My reason's are as follows:

- Flaxmere: Flaxmere is underrepresented by a huge margin of 14% in this proposal. It is irresponsible to take away one of Flaxmere's seats knowing that it is a lowsocioeconomic area, and seeing a lot of growth occurring over the next few years (ie. The new housing developments)
 - a. For some councillors to suggest that this underrepresentation will be accounted for by the fact that 40% of Flaxmere is M\u00e4orl is utterly ridiculous. It is unfair to impose this added burden of representation onto the M\u00e4orl councillors when this same burden is not imposed on other wards. This would not stand for any other ward, nor should it for Flaxmere
- 2. Remuneration: Council should consider remuneration as part of the review, as the number of councillors directly affects salary and affects the case they would have in applying for a higher remuneration allocation. Increasing council size will decrease the amount councillors are paid. This makes the role best fitted to those who are independently wealthy or receiving superannuation. This is a step backwards to making the role accessible to those who can't have full time jobs alongside being a councillor, and are young and having to pay high rent or raise a family. The current council does not represent the age diversity of Hastings, and reducing council size which increases the salary would make it easier for more people (including young people) to run for council.
- Efficiency: Increasing the size of council means there are too many voices at the table, and forming consensus will be harder. We don't need more councillors, but less – and councillors who are paid more and can dedicate more time to the role.
- 4. Rural Community: The Rural Community see's over-representation and with Flaxmere being underrepresented in the same proposal, this is unacceptable. If anything, Flaxmere should be the group being over-representation as it has a larger population to cater for. Fair representation for both the Rural Community as well as Flaxmere is important. The current proposal does not do this.

I urge council to not pass this proposal as it is highly flawed, and does not provide fair and effective representation as the legislation mandates.

To the Hastings District Council

I am writing to express my concern for the initial proposal of the current Representation Review.

Council has the obligation under the Local Electoral Act 2001 to provide 'fair and effective representation for individuals and communities', not 'some' communities. I do not believe this initial proposal achieves this requirement because:

- a) It does not seek to address the current under-representation of youth and young working age people,
- b) It under-represents the Flaxmere Community by a margin of 14%.

Under-representation of youth and young working age people

Currently, only one councillor, 7.14% of councillors, are under the age of 40, whilst a large 29.35% of our Hastings population is between the ages of 14 and 40. This is a failure of the current model and is not addressed in the proposal. I believe it is important that an equal to population proportion of councilors are within this age bracket as many people of these ages share many significant concerns and issues, which need to be represented equitably. For example, the housing crisis and climate change.

I believe irregular councilor working hours and low salary are the main barriers to youth and young full-time working age people, as most don't have the financial means to forgo their fulltime job in order to become a councilor, and because it is unrealistic for many employers to provide flexible working hours. Only the independently wealthy, superannuants, and business owner (who chose their hours) have the finances and time to take on the role.

As such I believe the Council should explore another proposal which sees the number of councilors decrease, in order to increase councillor salary, to make the position more financially palatable for youth and young fulltime working age people (as councillor salary is divided evenly from the remuneration funds)

The Flaxmere Community is Under-Represented
