1.0 Purpose and summary - Te Kaupapa Me Te Whakarāpopototanga

- 1.1 The purpose of this Report is for Council to receive the Heretaunga Locality Plan (Plan) dated April 2023.
- 1.2 The Plan outlines how Hastings District seeks to recover from the impacts of Cyclone Gabrielle. It captures immediate priorities and actions to be undertaken to enable communities to stand strong again and lay the framework for Heretaunga to build back better and more resilient.
- 1.3 The Plan is attached as **Attachment 1**. This version is in basic text. A graphic designed version is being produced.
- 1.4 This first edition of the Plan has been prepared with haste for the Regional Recovery Agency (Agency) so the Agency can start signalling to Central Government the scale of investment and decisions required to support Recovery activities for Hastings District and Hawke's Bay Region.
- 1.5 The Disclaimer and Introduction explain, this 'First Edition' of the Plan has been prepared in a very short timeframe, without the usual standard of care and audit that would ordinarily be expected for a Council strategic planning process.
- 1.6 Council reserves in its Disclaimer, the ability to update information at any time, noting information provided to date is on an interim basis only.
- 1.7 The next iteration of the Plan is due in August 2023. This timeframe provides Council and Mana Whenua Partners the opportunity to engage with affected communities more comprehensively and produce a Plan edition that more accurately reflects the bespoke Recovery aspirations of individual communities.
- 1.8 The Chief Executive is increasing Council capacity to both continue to deliver its 'Business as Usual' activities under the Council Annual Plan, and additional activities required for Recovery.

- 1.9 As detailed in the Recovery Update Report to the Council, received at the Council meeting on 18 April 2023, officers are preparing comprehensive reports for future Council meetings for Council decisions on the major areas of Recovery activity that Council is investing its resources into.
- 1.10 The first Report is on Waste Stream Activities. This Report comes to Council next week on 11 May 2023.

- B) That Council receive the Heretaunga Locality Plan.
