- A) That Council receive the report titled Whakatū West Stormwater Scheme consideration of submissions dated 17 June 2025.
- B) That in pursuit of option 3 in the officer's report, the Council defers final decision making on this matter and instructs the Chief Executive to:



- 1. Obtain professional advice on what could be an appropriate differentially based (tiered) targeted rate in light of the feedback received to date;
- 2. The Chief Executive to investigate alternative repayment terms for any targeted rate, and public good considerations.
- 3. If the Chief Executive considers a plausible differentially based scheme has been identified, then that scheme should be discussed with the landowners in the area; and
- 4. That the results of (2) be brought to Council for decision making, and that is to include another opportunity to the landowners to comment on and speak to Council about the matter.
- That the Chief Executive be directed to having items 1 4 above investigated, and consulted with affected property owners prior to the October 2025 Local Government Elections.
- C) That the Council treat with urgency the engagement with the Hawke's Bay Regional Council to assess and determine the current level of protection of the low section of stopbank identified by this scheme (as noted in submissions) within 12 months to a satisfactory level for all parties.
