# 4. HASTINGS DISTRICT COUNCIL - WASTE MANAGEMENT AND MINIMISATION PLAN IMPLEMENTATION UPDATE

(Document 21/274)

Waste Planning Manager, Angela Atkins spoke to her report and responded to questions from the Committee.

The Committee noted that a written update report had not been prepared for Napier City Council and asked Manager Environmental Solutions, Cameron Burton, (Napier City Council) to provide a verbal update on behalf of Napier City Council.

#### Kerbside Refuse Service:

- The new contract started 6 months ago and is now settling in.
- There was a lack of consistency in collection of bins.
- Lack of data provision on bins being picked up.
- Bin breakages had occurred early on but that problem has now been fixed.
- There had been 3 gas cylinder incidents. A social media campaign has been run around the dangers of gas cylinders in rubbish & correct disposal options.

### Kerbside Recycling Service:

- There has been a successful uptake by residents and presentation rates demonstrate this.
- 186 tonnes per month collected (around 30% higher than expected).
- 764 average lifts per day (Paper and cardboard).
- Large variation claim received.
- Fleet renewals are complete.

#### Waste Minimisation:

- Supportive of the "again again" cup initiative.
- Focus is on creating diversion opportunities at the transfer station.
- Deloitte audit of the Waste Levy spend will be presented to the Sustainable Napier meeting directly.
- Cameron Burton & Rhett van Veldhuizen attended the WasteMinz Study Tour Hawke's Bay
   Section.
- Recruitment underway for Waste Minimisation and Sustainability Officers.
- An invitation had been received to attend the Canterbury Civil Defence & Emergency Managers Disaster Waste Forum.



#### **Transfer Station:**

- Changes happening at the Redcliffe Refuse transfer Station. City Services and pit operator/bulk haulage contractor departing site on 30 June 2021.
- Engagement of interim solution underway.
- A one year short term contract for bulk haulage operation, site operations and services provider awarded to commence 1 July 2021.
- An extension of Armourguard Kiosk and cash handling contract has been made to align with the one year short term contract. This kiosk contact will now end 30 June 2022.
- Focus is being placed on customer experience and diversion of materials.
- Longer term procurement is underway. Expression of interest is complete and respondents have been shortlisted.
