

this report we have drawn attention to the fact that this wahi whenua is inextricably linked with 800–1,000 years of whakapapa. Its soils contain the blood of our tipuna (transl. ancestors) and taonga (transl. cultural artefacts) that constitute a vitally important cultural heritage for the marae hapû of Heretaunga. This wahi whenua represents a complex layering of domains of tapu and noa that are linked with the former expressions of kawa, kaupapa and tikanga by our tipuna (transl. ancestors). The status 'wahi whenua' recognises that this is not only an outstanding natural landscape, it is a landscape what has been shaped by centuries of human occupation.




Figure 28 A map of the Te Matā ... Te Mata te Tipuna study area that depicts recommended planning zones in addition to the existing Outstanding Natural Landscape zone and registered archaeological sites (Source: LINZ base map, Adam Forbes 2018, Landcare Research PNW).
