The Chief Executive noted that the majority of people who were likely to go to Splash Planet were families with children, with a high percentage of those children being under 12 years old who currently cannot be vaccinated against Covid-19.

The meeting was advised that the timeframes for undertaking vaccinations of children under 12 were unknown at this stage. With the Council needing to manage any risk to public health, a workshop will be held on Tuesday, 26 October 2021 involving the Chief Executive and the Chief Medical Officer of Health of the HB District Health Board to discuss the effect of the upcoming government Covid announcement on Friday, 22 October 2021.

It was suggested that given the above circumstances and the timing of the government announcement, it would be appropriate to leave the report to lie on the table to be uplifted and addressed at the next scheduled Council meeting on Thursday, 28 October 2021.
