4. TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES - MŌTEO PĀ ROAD - 13 NOVEMBER - WAIKOAU ROAD - 14 NOVEMBER AND GIMBLETT ROAD - 28 NOVEMBER 2021

Officers advised that since the agenda for this meeting had been created, the Hawke's Bay Car Club had withdrawn its application for the temporary closure of Waikoau Road on 14 November 2021 and this event had been cancelled. An email (CG-16-14-00255) had been sent from the car club to HDC confirming the cancellation of this event.

- A) That the Civic and Administration Subcommittee receive the report titled Temporary Road Closures Mōteo Pā Road, 13 November; Waikoau Road, 14 November; and Gimblett Road, 28 November 2021 dated 4 November 2021.
- B) That the Civic and Administration Subcommittee <u>approve</u> the following temporary road closures (excluding the application to temporarily close Waikoau Road on 14 November 2021 as this event has been cancelled) as no submissions have been received in respect of these applications:

The Hawke's Bay Car Club:

Mōteo Pā Road from rapid number 265 to the blind end of the road. The road closure will be between 9:00am and 5:00pm, Saturday, 13 November 2021. The purpose of this road closure is to hold a motorsport event.

Gimblett Road the entire length. The road closure will be between 9:00am – 5:00pm, Sunday, 28 November 2021. The purpose of this road closure is hold a motorsport event.

Subject to the following conditions to be complied with to the satisfaction of the Group Manager: Asset Management:

- i. These events are conducted in accordance with the New Zealand Transport Agency Code of Practice Temporary Traffic Management (CoPTTM).
- ii. The Traffic Management Plans including provision for appropriate signage is approved by the Traffic Management Coordinator acting under delegated authority.
- iii. The Traffic Management Plans must be complied with including any specific conditions.



- iv. Copies of the relevant liability insurance policies are received.
- v. That the cost of all advertising is met by the event organisers.
- vi. Emergency Services are contacted regarding the holding of this event with details of the dates, locations and time frames.
- vii. As per the Traffic Management Plan provisions all emergency services will be accommodated and access provided through the sites as required.
- viii. The applicant is responsible under the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 for all health and safety risks associated with this activity and must take reasonably practicable steps to ensure the safety of all persons during these temporary road closures.
- ix. The applicant has in place at all times, appropriate Health and Safety measures (to prevent harm to any persons), including (but not limited to) any measures provided for in the submitted Health and Safety Plans including any conditions attached.
- x. The Hawke's Bay Car Club events shall be conducted in accordance with the requirements of the Motorsport New Zealand Motor Sport Manual, National Sporting Code and Appendices.
